Life in the Seminary:

What it is, How it Works, and Why it's There

What is life in the seminary like? Is it basically a fraternity, but instead of partying they pray? Do they just pray and go to classes? When you enter, do you have to be ordained?

While the basic understanding of what Catholic seminary is known (a place to train potential-future priests), much of the life in the seminary is quite unknown to anyone not in regular contact with a seminarian.
