## "Folk School" Style Adult Education Community Classes

**St. Boniface Church** at 9367 Wattsburg Rd in Erie, PA is happy to announce the classes for the Summer Session of a free-of-charge, adult Folk School starting in May 2024. Classes will be filled on a "first come, first served" basis. Below are the class offerings for the Summer Session 2024:

<b>Class Title</b>	<b>Installing Vinyl Siding</b>
<b>Summary</b>	Learn how to install vinyl siding on homes, garages, sheds or any other building. This is a hands-on learning class.
<b>Materials Required</b>	Students should bring a hammer, tape measure, gloves, safety glasses, and paper and pen to take notes
<b>Class Start Date</b>	Monday, June 3rd
<b>Time</b>	Mondays from 6:30 to 8:00 pm
<b>Location</b>	Coleman Center at St. Boniface
<b>Number of Sessions</b>	Three Sessions

<b>Class Title</b>	<b>Craft Classes</b>
<b>Summary</b>	In this class you will learn four crafts: <b>Fabric painting a T-shirt</b> - Applying simple patterns to t-shirts <b>Creating a paper roses wreath</b> - Learn to spin paper roses from old book pages or old sheet music <b>Creating wall-hanging sunflowers from cloth</b> - Cutting cloth, assembling on rings and hanging <b>Bejeweling inside a photo frame</b> - Learn to arrange and glue bits of jewelry on the background sheet, making trees, angels, or geometric patterns
<b>Materials Required</b>	Classes require students bring work materials including: a washed, light-colored t-shirt and 2 styrofoam take-out containers, 1/2" paintbrush, 12" styrofoam wreath, choice of papers, hot glue gun or glue stick, scissors, 1 yard of "sunny" cloth, canning ring and seal, old junk/broken jewelry, glue, tweezers and an 8x10 photo frame. Instructor will notify students what to bring for each class

<b>Class Title</b>	<b>Flower Pounding on Cloth</b>
<b>Summary</b>	Use a hammer to transfer the colors of flowers, grasses, and weeds onto cloth.
<b>Materials Required</b>	Students should bring a regular hammer and colorful flowers, etc., hearing protection, and a piece of cereal-type cardboard approximately 12"x12". Instructor will supply the cloth.

<b>Class Title</b>	<b>Developing a Results-Generating Resume</b>
<b>Summary</b>	Learn how to write an effective resume for submitting to job postings. Class will make use of much two-way interaction with the class participants to demonstrate how to personalize your resume for a targeted job opportunity. Topics would include: structuring a resume, developing key job/results oriented statements, resume length, and follow-up after submitting a resume. Class will be lead by a career HR professional.
