**Step 1.** Access the "Student Enrollment Page" by clicking the corresponding link shown above.

**Step 2.** Complete the online enrollment form by providing the requested information under the "User Information" section of page.

**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:**

- All information **EXCEPT "EMS Cert #"** and **"Date of Birth"** are required in order to receive a course completion card.
- You will receive your CPR course completion card electronically at the email address you provide on the course enrollment page.

**Step 3.** Scroll down to the bottom of the enrollment page and click on the check box to indicate that you agree to the terms and conditions of the registration.

**Step 4.** Click the "Sign Up" button located at the bottom of the page.

Once you have successfully submitted your registration, you will receive an on-screen message that says your **Enrollment has been submitted successfully**. Participants should also receive an auto-generated confirmation email at the email address entered on the online enrollment form.

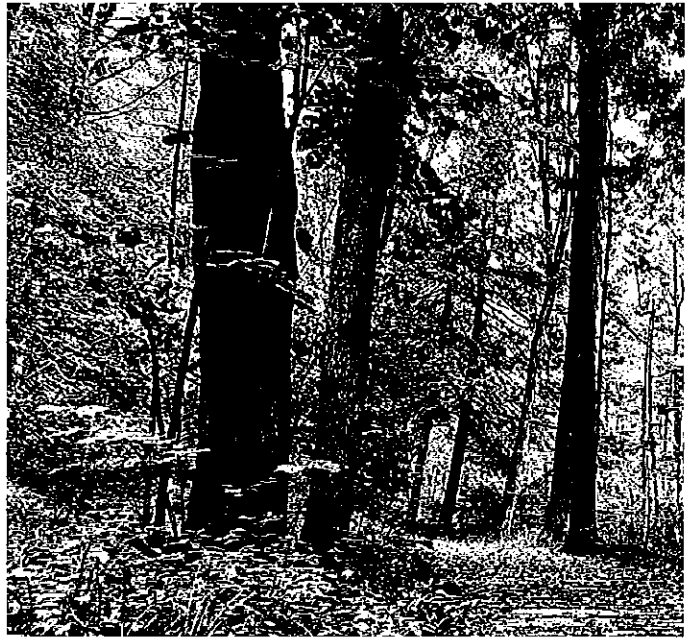
**IMPORTANT:** Students should review their course confirmation email carefully as it may contain specific information and instructions participants may need to complete before attending the course.
