

- 9. Persons tending graves or visiting the cemetery are responsible for disposing of their own trash (weeds, dead flowers, pots, etc.) at home, in the cemetery trash bin, or in the parish dumpster. No trash is to be deposited in the brush or wooded areas, over the embankment, or any other place on cemetery or parish property.
- 10. No one is permitted to adjust any markers without the express permission of the Cemetery Committee.
- 11. Summer decorations are to be removed by October 31st.
- 12. Winter decorations are to be removed by April 30^{th} .



Policies

A crucial part of the mission of Mount of Olives Cemetery is to provide and maintain a beautiful, prayerful, respectful place for our deceased loved ones and their families. That requires the cooperation of everyone who visits here. In the interest of promoting this mission, we ask everyone to please observe the following policies.

- 1. All are welcome to visit the cemetery during daylight hours.
- All visitors are to respect the sanctity of the cemetery grounds at all times and to avoid any noise or activity that would disrupt that environment.
- 3. No pets other than service animals are permitted at any time.
- 4. Grass may be cleared away from monuments up to 15 inches on each side.
- No gravel, stones, bricks, lumber, plastic tubing, or other permanent or dangerous materials may be used to edge monuments or gravesites.
- Mulch, fill dirt, and other landscaping materials owned by the cemetery are for Cemetery Committee use only. No one else is permitted to use these materials without the express permission of the Cemetery Committee.
- 7. Unmaintained plants, including in-ground plants, will be removed.
- No shrubs or bushes are permitted. Trees may be planted in memory of the deceased with the express permission of the Cemetery Committee. All others will be removed.

Our Mission


