I am not an uber-healthy eater but I lean on the healthy side. Occasionally, I really do enjoy ice cream, chocolate, Diet Coke, really good McChicken from McDonalds, etc. and the list could continue for quite some time. Overall, I lean on an avoidance of artificial sugars and I try to eat a variety of colors. I enjoy the science behind putrition but I have had to practically simplify it avoid


