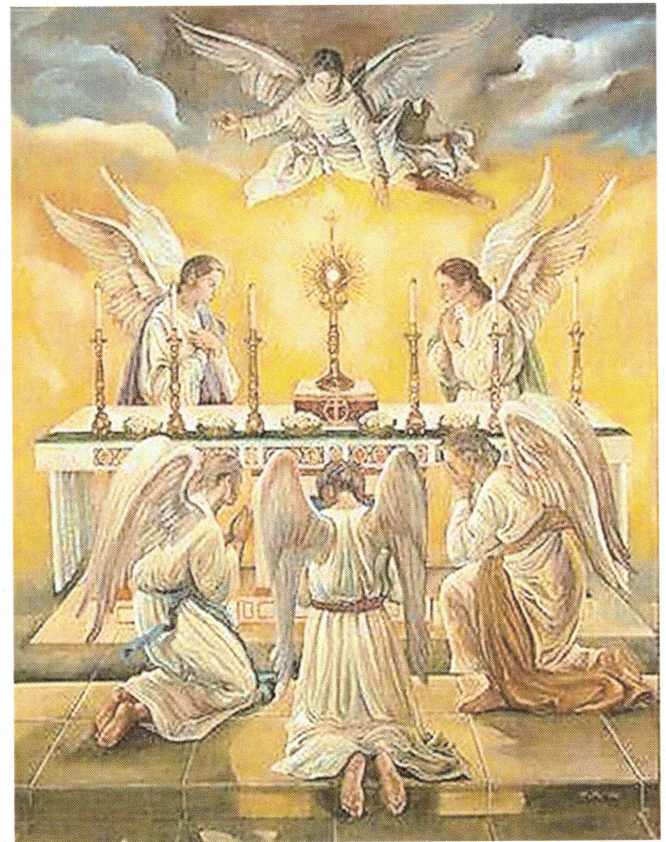
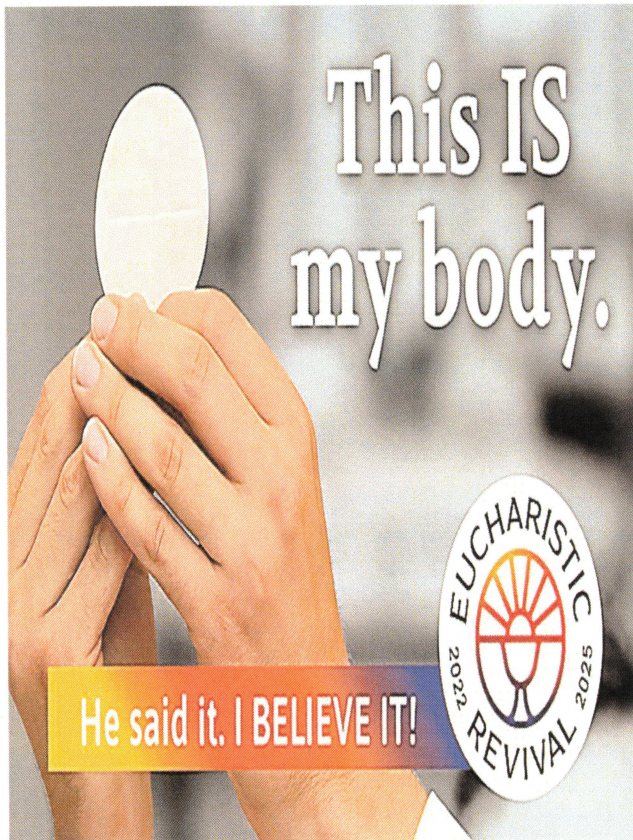


# Diocesan Eucharistic Day + October 15 & 16, 2022
