A WORD FROM FR. BRANDON

This past week, July 14, was the feast day of whom I have come to claim as my Patron Saint, Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. When I was in college at Gannon, there was an opportunity for me to go on a service trip to Whitehorse, SD, which is on the Cheyenne River Sioux Reservation, to work with the school-aged children in an after-school program. We were there for a week, and I left a piece of my heart there – it was simply transformational. We drove there and saw some amazing and breathtaking landscapes throughout that long road trip. A crazy story is that we stopped at Mt. Rushmore, and we ended up parking our Econoline van between two other cars with PA plates. The car to our right was a family from Grove City, and the car to our left was a family from out east but was originally from Meadville! What are the odds?! Anyway, on the reservation, it was about 10 of us Gannon students offering after-school activities for the kids until dark. The town was in the Central Time Zone, but the kids’ school was in the Mountain Time Zone, so they left home by 7 AM to get to school by 7 AM; they also lost an hour coming home – it was wild! During the day while the kids were at school, we interacted with the local communities of the reservation and learned about their life and their culture – it was a humble and simple way of life, but one steeped in immense beauty, history, and spirituality. The town of Whitehorse where we were staying and running the after-school program was nothing more than trailers and modular homes strewn about the vast prairie with a small ‘downtown’ with a church and a post office. The Church of this town was, I believe, St Theresa Church, but there was great devotion to Saint Kateri there among the community. It was the first I had ever heard of her or encountered her, but the meaningfulness of having a canonized saint of the Church, and the hope that offered to this community, was something that I could truly sense from the residents. The reservation was, and I assume still is, very poor. The county it is in was at one time the poorest county in the US! The scars of poverty were all around Whitehorse: 30%+ unemployment, alcoholism and addiction, and horrifying teen suicide rates were heart-wrenching realities of this town, and we had the august honor to go there for a mere week and do what we could to offer some light and some joy to the dark storms of their lives. I have pictures of that trip and, with that trip now being 15 years ago this summer, I wonder what became of those kids. I wonder if they’re even still alive, did they find opportunity, did they maintain the brilliant light of their youth while living in such perilous darkness. I will never know this side of heaven what ever became of them, but 15 years later, I still think of them and pray for them. It was a year later that I coincidentally found myself at the tomb of St Kateri in Kahnawake, Quebec! I was in Quebec for an international Eucharistic Congress–Bishop Trautman had taken the seminarians to it in the summer of 2008, and we happened to stop at her tomb. It was the first tomb of a saint I had ever visited, and it was in the wake of an experience that was still so fresh and raw for me from the previous summer! I have a vivid memory still of just praying in awe that a saint of the

Universal Church was right there in my midst, in a simple quiet church on a reservation in Quebec. It was so powerful that I asked her to be my patron there on that visit. Since then, she has been my best saint friend! I love the saints, and I will share with you stories of them throughout our years together, but Kateri just holds a place in my heart like no one else! I encourage you, in the life of your faith, to foster deep and lasting relationships, not only with each other but with the saints in Heaven. Their heavenly ministry towards us is to lovingly intercede for us and to teach us through the story and wisdom of their lives how to be where they are, to become what they became. I can’t encourage you strongly enough about how rich it is to have friends who are saints in paradise loving you, knowing you, and you knowing them and loving them! The poverty and brutality of the world towards those children in Whitehorse didn’t dull their devotion and love of God and His saint, Kateri. It inspired me and made me want to know her as they knew her, and I can say it has been one of the pillars of my faith and spiritual life!

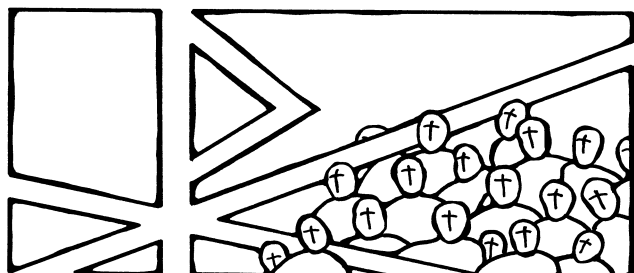

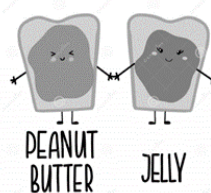
