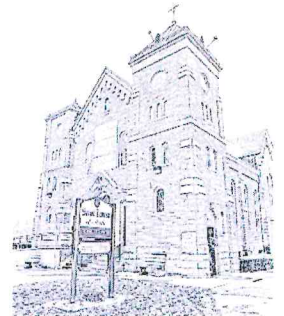

Welcome to the 2023 – 2024 Faith Formation year! Classes for our Faith Formation program will be starting Sunday September 17, 2023. Please see the 23-24 schedule for Pre-K thru 8th grade. The schedule for Confirmation will be handed out at the parent meeting.

This year we will be implementing two new and exciting programs – EDGE for middle school and PURPOSE for Confirmation! EDGE and PURPOSE are Catholic youth ministry programs. These programs provide a safe fun place for youth to build a solid Catholic community, to get answers to their questions about faith, and, most importantly, to experience Jesus in a profound and personal way.

- Confirmation this year will include **9th and 10th** grade
- Parent meetings:
 - Grades 9 & 10 to discuss Confirmation and the PURPOSE program:
 - St Thomas – Saturday 9-9 after 4:30pm Mass in the multipurpose room
 - St Teresa – Sunday 9-10 after 6:00 pm in the parish center
 - Grades 6-8 to discuss the EDGE program:
 - St Thomas – Sunday 9-10 after 8:00 am Mass in the multipurpose room
 - St Teresa – Sunday 9-10 after 10:00 am Mass in the Parish Center

This school year, both Sts Thomas & Teresa programs will be implementing a small monetary charge of \$25 per student. This fee is to help offset the cost of books, materials, and support for our new EDGE/PUPROSE programs. If this fee is a hardship for your family, please reach out to Fr Tom or myself.

We recognize that parents are the primary educators of their children, and “receive the responsibility and privilege of evangelizing their children” (CCC 2225). Therefore, we ask that you participate in your child’s faith formation in one of more of the following volunteer opportunities. Please complete the following and return with the registration form.

Check all the boxes for which you want to participate. Please choose at least one.

- Catechist** – Responsible for teaching lessons every Sunday, is familiar with teaching from a textbook, leads prayer, models the Catholic Christian life.
- Assistant Catechist** – Helps the Catechist every Sunday with lessons, activities, snacks, classroom management, etc.
- Substitute Catechist** – On call to substitute teach when a Catechist is not available; please mark grades willing to sub for:
 - Grades K-1
 - Grades 2-3
 - Grades 4-5
 - Grades 6-8
 - Grades 9-11
- Retreat Team** – Assists in planning and executing retreats for various grades. May include set up/tear down, food pick up, on site for duration of retreat
- Chaperone** – Will be asked to attend various events when more adult chaperones are needed. At least one adult chaperone for every 10 children above fourth grade, and one adult for every 5 children in fourth grade and younger.
- Religious Ed Office Assistant** – Available in the main office during religious education classes to assist in finding supplies, using the copy machine, lets people in to the building while the doors are locked and signs them in.
- Prayer Warrior** – Dedicates a time to pray specifically for the religious education program and our mission of making disciples.
- Childcare Provider** – Babysit for young children during various adult faith formation events.
- Children’s Liturgy** – Lead the younger children of the parish at their level during the Mass.

Safe Environment Tips for Parents and Caregivers 2023-2024

Every child deserves a
safe environment.



Ministry to children and
young people is a
privilege, not a right.

Did you know...

In the Diocese of Erie, in order to work with children, an adult must :

- ⇒ Obtain the state of Pennsylvania required clearances.
- ⇒ Complete Safe Environment training that includes how to recognize and report child abuse.
- ⇒ Complete an application.
- ⇒ Sign a statement saying they will follow the Policy for the Protection of Children.
- ⇒ Sign a statement acknowledging they are mandated reporters, required to report child abuse.

A list of the required documentation for clergy, employees, and volunteers can be found on the Protection of Children webpage of the diocesan website, www.eriercd.org.

Did you know....

- ⇒ The Office for the Protection of Children and Youth visits parishes and catholic schools to check for compliance.
- ⇒ The Diocese is audited yearly by an independent firm to evaluate implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Youth People at the diocesan level and parish/school level.

What Parents and all other adults can do....

Watch for these warning signs of abuse in children:

No longer wants to see a particular person they had been close to

Declining academic performance

Demonstrates aggressive behavior or constantly angry

Changes in personality or mood

Tries to hide use of technology

Depression or anxiety

No longer interested in activities they used to enjoy

Loss of appetite or changes in eating habits

Withdraws from family or friends



Commits physical and emotional boundary violations

... and these warning signs of Perpetrators

Does not believe the rules apply to them (or, does not follow rules or protocols)

Gives lavish gifts to minors

Keeps secrets with minors

Allows or encourages minors to break laws or rules

Has inappropriate or suggestive conversations with minors

Is overly interested in spending time with minors

Takes photos without approval, or asks minors to send them

Tries to get minors alone

Boundary violations committed by employees and volunteers working in parishes and catholic schools can be reported to the Office for the Protection of Children and Youth.
