



Money Counters Needed



Points to Ponder

As Christian Catholics we are challenged to cultivate a healthy relationship with the Lord through prayer. Fortunately, Christ Himself catechized the apostles and all of us on the proper way to pray. The Our Father, or, The Lord's Prayer was the perfect prayer; and after two thousand years it still is. The Our Father contains all of the important elements of prayer: Praise, Petition, Contrition, and Thanksgiving. The gospel from Luke not only provides us with this prayer, but also shares Jesus' attitude about prayer; be persistent! Jesus says: "...ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." Abraham was tenacious when he petitioned God to be just in His treatment of the innocent in Sodom and Gomorrah. God in His mercy was considerate of Abraham's request. Be assured that God will hear our prayers and answer them with great love and understanding.
